

Describe a specific situation where you had to deal with a challenging new social environment or cross-cultural interaction. What strategies did you use? Do you think the same strategies will be useful while on exchange, or what others will you use?



Recommendations

Two recommendations are required. Please note:

- It is best practice to ask your recommenders if they are willing to recommend you, and then fill in their email addresses below, at least 10 days ahead of the application deadline.
- Let your recommenders know when the deadline is, that they will get an automated email, and that they can either fill out a short form OR upload a recommendation letter.
- The email sent to non-UAF recommenders may go to their spam folder. Please ask them to check it. The email will come from messages@via-trm.com.
- At least one recommendation must come from a university instructor who has had you in class. Instructors can include graduate student teaching assistants (TAs), as long as they can attest to your academic abilities.
- The second recommendation may come from a supervisor or an instructor. You
 cannot use family members as a reference even if they happen to be your
 supervisor.


