Lab Guidelines for DVM Students

1. NO FOOD OR DRINK IN LAB.

2. NO PHOTOGRAPHY OF ANY KIND.

- 3. ALWAYS wear appropriate attire in laboratory:
 - a. No open-toed shoes / no sandals.
 - b. Wear required smocks, lab coats, coveralls or scrubs.
 - c. Wear gloves & safety glasses during dissections.
 - d. Long hair must be tied back.
- 4. NO Cell phones (prior faculty approval is REQUIRED if you are expecting an emergency call).
- 5. NO visitors without prior approval from teaching faculty and Associate Dean.
- 6. NO tours during lab/lecture periods.
- 7. NO dirty smocks/scrubs/gloves in common areas of building.
- 8. NO backpacks/purses in lab area. Leave your personal items in your lockers.
- 9. DO NOT prop doors open at any time.
- 10. DO NOT use instructor computer station.
- 11. ALWAYS clean up afterwards! Replace stools on table and wipe everything down including the stools, computer, computer station, table and floor.
- 12. ALWAYS dispose of scalpel blades and other sharps in sharps container.
- 13. REMEMBER to leave the area as you would expect it to be:
 - a. Be respectful of others.
 - b. If the lab is being used, request entry do not enter unless invited.
